

Name of Form:

Writ of Election.

Section Reference:

Sections 3.004, 3.006, and 4.007, Texas Election Code.

Purpose:

Notify Presiding Judge of his duty to hold the election in his precinct.

Number of Copies Required:

One for each Presiding Judge.

Completed by:

Authority responsible for giving notice of the election.

Filing Date:

Not later than 15 days before date of election or seven days after the election is ordered, whichever is later.

Filed with:

Presiding Judge of each election precinct in which the election is to be held.

Comments:

This writ of election is used for all other elections except for November General Election.

This notice may be combined with the notice of appointment pursuant to Section 4.007, which is required in accordance with Section 32.009 to be delivered to each presiding judge not later than the 20th day after the date of the appointment. If the notices are combined, both must be delivered by the date required in the earlier notice.
